- Play with the children and direct their play.
- Always tell parents about any diaper / feeding events.
- Work with Early Childhood Coordinator to coordinate contact with visitors and new members
- Ensure that the Nursery room has been properly cleaned after each use to reduce the risk of spreading germs.
- Pray for each child and their family.
